NOTE: The overall average Vehicle License Fee (VLF) is \$75 per vehicle, and the overall Total fee paid per vehicle registration is \$162.

* Effective May 19, 2009, the VLF will increase from 0.65% of the assessed value of a vehicle to 1.15% of the assessed value. The amount of VLF is then distributed: 0.65% is split between the Local Revenue Fund and the Motor Vehicle License Fee Account, 0.35% to the General Fund, and 0.15% to the Local Safety and Protection Account.

** The first \$122 of the CVRA fee is allocated to the Motor Vehicle Account.
