Subject: 2009 Delay of Enforcement
California International Registration Plan (IRP)

The California Department of Motor Vehicles will be converting all California-based IRP accounts to staggered registration beginning January 1, 2009; therefore, this will be the last year that all California-based IRP accounts will expire on December 31. California statute requires renewal fees to be paid by midnight of the expiration date.

The California Department of Motor Vehicles is requesting each jurisdiction to delay enforcement of California IRP through February 28, 2009, for any vehicle that has valid 2008 California IRP plates and cab card or temporary operating authority (REG 3100 or REG 2126 IRP) that expires on December 31, 2008. Temporary operating authority that expires before December 31, 2008, is not included in this delay of enforcement.

IRP applications are being processed according to the date received in our Sacramento Headquarters. Temporary operating authority is issued once payment and verification of insurance are recorded. Please disseminate this information to all interested persons or agencies within your jurisdiction.
