New E-mail Alert Distribution

Effective immediately, two new industry categories are included in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) E-mail Alert Service. These industry customers receive e-mail notification, when new memos or publications are placed on the DMV Internet website. The e-mail alert service provides the industry with current information to conduct DMV business. The new industry categories are the Mature Driver Program and the Employer Testing Program.

E-Mail Alerts

The Occupational Licensing Branch administers the Mature Driver Program and the Employer Testing Program. The branch is adding these industry programs to the DMV E-mail Alert Service. This online system is located on the DMV website, at dmv.ca.gov.

We encourage you to subscribe to the DMV E-mail Alert Service. This time-saving service is environmentally friendly by eliminating paper, which saves public funds.

Sign up for the free DMV E-mail Alert Service, by following these instructions:

- Simply key in your e-mail address to sign-up for the DMV e-mail alerts.
