

Permanent Vessel Number and Temporary Certificate of Number

New Policy

DMV **will not accept** a Permanent Vessel Number and Temporary Certificate of Number (BOAT 102) with any alterations or erasures for vessel transactions with a sale/transfer date on or after August 1, 2007.

Procedures

Complete the BOAT 102 as stated in the *Agent's Handbook for Registration of Undocumented Vessels* Section 4.010. If any alterations or erasures are made, the form **must** be voided and a new BOAT 102 completed.

NOTE: Vessel agents are required to provide new vessel owners the Carbon Monoxide and ABC's of Boating pamphlets. These pamphlets may be obtained from the Department of Boating and Waterways.
