

Online Vehicle Registration Fee Calculator—New Options

New Information

Two new options have been added to the online Vehicle Registration Fee Calculator:

- Determine registration renewal fees.
 - Customers can now determine the vehicle registration renewal fees up to 75 days prior to the vehicle's expiration date. If the fee calculator is used more than 75 days prior to the vehicle's expiration date, an error message will display.
- Determine registration fees for a California used vehicle purchase.
 - Customers can now determine vehicle transfer fees, use tax, renewal fees, and other fees that may be due on a California used vehicle purchase.

Procedures

To access the Vehicle Registration Fee Calculator, log on to the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) Internet website at dmv.ca.gov, click on the Internet Options Tab or the "Save Time. Go Online!" computer monitor graphic. Then click on the Vehicle Registration Fee Calculator link, select the desired calculation, and follow the instructions on the screen.

Background


Previously, customers could only use the Vehicle Registration Fee Calculator to determine registration fees for new or nonresident vehicles, or determine vehicle license fees paid for tax purposes.
