

Identification for the Dealer Examination Class

Issue Date: May 7, 2015

New Information

Effective immediately, out-of-state dealers may present an unexpired alternative photo identification (ID) document issued by a U.S. federal, state, or territory government agency for the dealer education **class**. For example, an unexpired:

- Driver license
- ID card
- U.S. military ID card
- U.S. Native American tribal photo ID card
- U.S. passport

IMPORTANT: A California driver license (DL) or ID is required for the dealer exam.

Procedures

A current California DL or ID card, or other photo ID, including those issued out-of-state, that verifies the identity of the applicant, may be accepted for the dealer education **class**.

Background

Currently, education providers only accept a California DL/ID as proof of ID for the dealer education class.
