

## **New Traffic Violator School (TVS) Requirements**

### **New Information**

Effective July 1, 2022, regulations clarifying TVS requirements are as follows:

- Defines 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. as the **regular business hours** a TVS is to remain open.
- Prohibits office closures for emergencies, illnesses, lunch hours, or scheduled vacations.
- Restricts a TVS from being located within 50 feet of another TVS's building wall.

### **Background**

On July 1, 2020, legislation established additional licensing requirements for existing and new TVSs.
