The school shall notify affected students a minimum of 4 days prior to the scheduled class in writing or by telephone. Schools with a website may elect to additionally post an alert message on their home page when a class is cancelled, pursuant to Section 345.41(a) California Code of Regulations. Class cancellations can be submitted on the Official School Class Cancellation for Standard/Emergency Notification, OL 749, available at www.dmv.ca.gov/forms/ol/ol749.pdf.
