

CDL TEST WAIVER FOR MILITARY MEMBERS

This Commercial Driver License (CDL) test waiver form may be used by military members who are currently licensed and who are or were employed within the past year (12 months) in a military position requiring the operation of a military motor vehicle equivalent to a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV). The Troops to Trucks military skills test waiver program allows a qualified military member to apply for a CDL without skills testing. CDL knowledge (written) test(s) may be waived for certain military occupations through the Even Exchange program. These programs do not waive school bus endorsement requirements.
