NOTE: Manufacturers that provide privately owned vehicles for non-commercial use shall report each instance of a dynamic driving task performance relevant system failure but are not required to provide the date and time of the occurrence, the longitude and latitude or the Vehicle Identification Number.

SUBMISSION DATE	Enter date the report was provided to the department. (YYYY-MM-DD)
ENTER REPORT DATE RANGE	Time period the report covers. (YYYY-MM-DD - YYYY-MM-DD)
PERMIT TYPE	Drivered AVT### or L3 Deployment AVD###
DATE	Date when the Dynamic Driving Task Performance Relevant System Failure occurred. (YYYY-MM-DD)
TIME	Time the Dynamic Driving Task Performance Relevant System Failure occurred in 24 -hour format (e.g. 24:00)
LATITUDE	Latitude of the Dynamic Driving Task Performance Relevant System Failure event location with 4 decimal places of precision.
LONGITUDE	Longitude of the Dynamic Driving Task Performance Relevant System Failure event location with 4 decimal places of precision. There is no minus sign. The longitude is understood to be west of meridian.
A DESCRIPTION OF THE UNDERLYING CAUSES USING THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES	<p>A description of the underlying causes using the following categories: type of software issue, type of hardware issue, actions of other road users, weather conditions, road surface or traffic conditions, construction, loss of communication, other emergencies, or collisions. The description should be written in plain language with enough detail that a non-technical person can understand the circumstances.</p> <p>Enter all underlying causes that apply:</p> <p>Software issue = 1 Hardware issue = 2 Actions of other road users = 3 Weather conditions = 4 Road surface or traffic conditions = 5 Construction = 6 Loss of communication = 7 Other emergencies = 8 Collisions = 9</p>
