

Notice of Proposed Emergency Action

August 21, 2026

The Department of Motor Vehicles (department) proposes to adopt Sections 26.04 and 26.06 in Article 2.1, related to English Language Proficiency Assessments for Commercial Drivers.

SUBMISSION OF COMMENTS

Government Code section 11346.1, subdivision (a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to the submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), the Department provide a notice of proposed emergency action (Finding of Emergency) and proposed text to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the Department.

After submission of the proposed emergency regulation to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulation as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6. The Proposed Text of the emergency regulation and the Finding of Emergency are posted on the Department's website at <https://oal.ca.gov/regulations>.

If you would like to comment on the Finding of Emergency or the proposed text, those comments must be made in writing only, must contain a notation that identifies the emergency regulation to which they relate, and must be received by both the Department and OAL within five calendar days of the Department's filing with OAL.
