

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS
AND ADDITION OF DOCUMENTS TO RULEMAKING FILE**

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Motor Vehicles is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulations originally noticed to the public in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 11, 2025, related to the translation of traffic violator school courses.

Additionally, pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8(d), 11346.9(a)(1), and 11347.1, the department is providing notice that documents have been added to the rulemaking file and are available for public inspection and comment.

- (4) The language now proposed to be repealed is shown with ~~double strikethrough~~.
