

Notice of Modification of Proposed Regulations

Title 13, Division 1, Chapter 1

Article 3.0 – Vehicle Registration and Titling

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Motor Vehicles is providing notice of changes made to the proposed regulations originally noticed to the public in the California Regulatory Notice Register on October 31, 2025.

Additionally, pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8(d), 11346.9(a)(1), and 11347.1, the department is providing notice that documents have been added to the rulemaking file and are available to the public for inspection and comment.

The documents added to the rulemaking file are as follows:

- Modified Regulatory Text
- Statement of Reasons for the Modified Regulatory Text

The text includes the originally proposed language as well as the proposed changes to the language. The language modifications are clearly illustrated by the following methods:

(1) The language originally proposed to be added to the text is single underlined.

(2) ~~The language originally proposed to be repealed is shown with single strikethrough.~~

(3) The language now proposed to be deleted which was originally proposed to be added is ~~double overstruck and single underlined~~.

(4) The language now proposed to be added is double underlined.
