

DICTIONARY

NOTE: Manufacturers that provide privately owned vehicles for non-commercial use shall report each instance of an immobilization, but are not required to provide the date and time of the occurrence or the longitude and latitude or Vehicle Identification Number

ENTER SUBMISSION DATE HERE	The date the manufacturer provided the report to the DMV. (YYYY-MM-DD)
ENTER REPORT DATE RANGE HERE	Time period the report covers. (YYYY-MM-DD - YYYY-MM-DD)
DATE	The date when the immobilization occurred (YYYY-MM-DD)
TIME	The time the immobilization occurred in 24 -hour format (e.g. 24:00)
VIN	17-Character vehicle identification number.
LATITUDE	Latitude of the immobilization location with 4 decimal places of precision.
LONGITUDE	Longitude of the immobilization location in decimal degrees with 4 decimal places of precision. There is no minus sign. The longitude is understood to be west of meridian.
SPEED LIMIT OF THE ROADWAY	The speed limit of the roadway where the vehicle immobilization occurred. (In meters per second)
LENGTH OF IMMOBILIZATION	Length of time (in minutes) the vehicle was stopped before it was driven by a human driver at the scene or a remote driver.
ACTIONS TAKEN TO REMOVE THE VEHICLE	The actions taken to remove the vehicle from where it stopped in the travel lane: driven by the autonomous test vehicle driver; driven by the remote driver; moved by command issued by the remote assistant; driven by first responder; driven by manufacturer's designee dispatched to stop location; towed away; or other actions taken.
TYPES OF EFFORTS TO MOVE A VEHICLE	Types of efforts to move a vehicle before manual intervention: automated driving system, remote assistance, or other.
