Location of vehicles are based on addresses provided by registered owners.

The following changes occurred from January 1, 2018 to October 1, 2018 report:

- Diesel and Diesel Hybrid have been combined as Diesel.
- Compressed Natural Gas and Natural Gas have been combined as Natural Gas.
- Propane, Butane, Methane, and Methanol have been combined as Other.
- FXE and FXM have been combined under FFV for Flex Fuel Vehicle for the October 1, 2018 CSV file as FXM is not a widely used fuel type.

Light versus heavy duty is based on gross vehicle weight of 10,000+ lbs. for heavy duty vehicles.

Driver Licenses Outstanding by County

This data consists of valid licenses outstanding (i.e., not expired more than 90 days). The value for ID cards includes both people who only have an ID card and people who have both an ID card and a license. Licenses are not issued by county. This is counting the number of valid licenses with an indicator on the record for the “county of residence” (normally tied to the residence address, but to the mailing address if a residence address is not present).

OUT OF STATE counts were not captured prior to 2000.

ID CARDS OUTSTANDING counts were not captured prior to 1985.
