New Information

Effective January 1, 2020, two occupational licensing-related fees will increase. These fees affect occupational licensees with identification license plates such as dealers, manufacturers, dismantlers, distributors, remanufacturers, and vehicle transporters.

Procedures

Programming will be in place to calculate the following fee increases:
