

## Appendix 1E - California License Plate Data (1914-1980)

### .0100 Year of Manufacture (YOM) License Plate program

*California Code of Regulations*, Title 13, Article 3.3, §§205.00–205.14

Year of Manufacture (YOM) License Plates were originally issued by the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). YOM License Plates will be authenticated by DMV personnel and:

- Must be supplied by the vehicle owner.
- Must display legible and unaltered characters.
- May be restored/painted but **cannot** deviate from the original colors or configurations.
- Validation year-stickers or tabs corresponding to the model year of the vehicle **must** be attached to the license plate prior to authentication by a DMV employee. .
- 1963 and newer configurations **must** be assigned to the specific vehicle for which it was intended (for example, auto plates to autos, commercial plates to commercial vehicles, trailer plates to trailers, and motorcycle plates to motorcycles).
- 1963–1969 year model automobiles **must** have black license plates with yellow characters within the alpha-numeric series of AAA000–YYY999.
- 1963–1969 year model commercial vehicles or pickups **must** have black license plates with yellow characters within the alpha-numeric series of A00000–Z99999 or 00000A-99999Z.
- 1970–1980 year model commercial vehicles or pickups **must** have blue license plates with yellow characters within the alpha-numeric series of 00000A–99999Z.
- 1975-1980 year model commercial vehicles or pickup trucks **may** also utilize blue license plates with yellow characters within the alpha-numeric series of 1A00001 to 3Z99999.
- 1970-1980 year model automobiles vehicles **must** have blue license plates with yellow characters within the alpha-numeric series of 000AAA-999ZZZ.
- 1980 year model automobiles vehicles autos **may** also utilize blue license plates with yellow characters within the alpha-numeric series of 1AAA000 to 1SZZ999.
- 1970-1980 year model motorcycles **must** have blue license plates with yellow characters within the alpha-numeric series of 0A0000-9Z9999.

Additional information on the YOM program:

- License plate colors may vary slightly due to age and exposure.
- License plates issued prior to 1956, when license plates were standardized, may vary in length and width by up to 1/8 of an inch.
- Environmental License Plates and Special Recognition License Plates are restricted from the YOM program.
